## WHAT YOU MAY NOT KNOW

High definition (1080i) is available from sources such as HDTV satellite receivers, HDTV digital cable boxes, or D-VHS. These signals are only available through component video cables. If your source does not have component video, S-Video is the next best connection. The "F" coax cable TV connection should never be used as the signal will not be high definition and has the worst possible picture and sound quality.

Some plasmas also have a subwoofer output which needs a subwoofer cable to hook-up to a quality subwoofer.
